SCHOOL REFERENCES FOR 2017 ADVANCE NOTICE

This process will begin in the autumn. As usual, Fr Deo will hold interviews based on the entry level of the children. At least one parent or guardian seeking a reference for their child must attend an interview at a scheduled interview session, together with the child, after having first completed an application form and provided a recent family photograph. (Application forms will be made available in the main porch in due course.) This process applies even if you have attended interviews in previous years. Please bring with you any forms which schools may have given you, and which require completion by Father Deo. Many forms will be sent directly to the parish office. References are given based on evidence of Catholic practice in respect of Mass attendance by parents and children. Please note that if you have only recently begun to attend Mass here, you may need to approach your previous parish priest. Details of the interview sessions will be announced by way of notices on the central notice boards in the front porch, either side of the central main doors. Please note that dates of interview sessions will not be published in the newsletter. It is therefore essential that you always check the notice boards for information when you attend Mass.

Please tell anybody you know, who may be seeking a reference, to ensure that they come here in order to find out when and where interview sessions will be held.

The Repository

Whilst essential repairs are carried out on the Repository, following the flooding which we experienced in recent months, a limited stock of Mass cards and greetings cards may be found in the little room behind Our Lady's Altar, bearing the notice "Temporary Repository. New drainage needs to be installed, with most of the work taking place outside the building. However, this could take some time. Once the floor is ready and safe to use, the Repository will reopen. At this point in time, we cannot give you a definite date.

VERY IMPORTANT GIFT AID INFORMATION:

Would all Gift Aiders, whether existing or new, please be aware that there have recently been significant changes to the tax system. Gift Aiders should therefore review very carefully whether or not they will be paying sufficient tax in 2016-17 in order to cover the Gift Aid that St Bartholomew's will claim back on their donations.

The major points that may take people out of paying sufficient tax are:

- a) The first £1,000 of investment income is tax free from 2016.
- b) The first £5,000 of Dividend Income is tax free.
- c) Tax free personal allowance is up to £11,000 from April 2016, rising to £12,500 in future.
- d) Higher Rate tax threshold rises to £43,000 from April 2016 It will be appreciated that many of our gift aid donors who rely on pensions and savings will be falling out of income tax completely (e.g. you would need to have bank savings and shares worth something over £100,000 to use up the two new tax-free allowances on interest and dividends) and many others too will no longer be paying tax.

Clearly, those Gift Aiders who are affected by these changes should advise the Parish Office if they will need to leave the Gift Aid scheme. Please be aware that all such matters are treated in the strictest confidence by the Gift Aid team and the parish office.

A few useful tips and requests for Gift Aid givers:

- 1/ If you miss a week or more, please don't worry! Just use your next envelope, and discard those from missed weeks.
- 2/ If you forget your envelope, there are some emergency envelopes in the porches. Just add your Gift Aid Number and date. For second collections, please add also the name of the collection on the front.
- 3/ Please don't use anybody else's envelope under any circumstances.
- 4/ Please do not mix first and second collections in one envelope.
- Always use a separate envelope for second collections.
- 5/ If you have moved parish, please advise the appropriate Gift Aid team at your previous parish and contact our own Gift Aid team to transfer to our scheme.
- 6/ If you give by Standing Order, you will still need envelopes for second collections.
- 7/ Please do not use out of date envelopes. Do contact the Gift Aid team if you need new ones. (See also Emergency Envelopes). 8/ Please carefully seal your envelope. If money escapes from the envelope it cannot be recorded against your Gift Aid number.
- 9/ If you are in any doubt about being in the Gift Aid scheme, please contact the Gift Aid team as soon as possible.
