#### MASS INTENTIONS

Please use only the special white self-seal envelopes provided in all porch areas. Ideally, a separate envelope should be used for each intention requested. You are kindly requested not to put multiple intentions together; these should normally be for one person, couple, family, or other intention, but not for long lists of people, as this detracts from focusing on a particular intention. Please note that there is NOT a charge for saying Masses. You are simply invited to make an offering which you can afford. As a guide, most people offer £10.00. You should never feel embarrassed about making an offering if you can't afford to. Please note that if you are a member of our Gift Aid Scheme, you may Gift Aid your Mass offerings. There is a special box for this purpose on the envelope, though please ensure that it is the number only of the person who is requesting the Mass.

#### PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE ABORTION LAW

Please remember to write to your MP, asking them to vote against the decriminalisation of abortion. There are special cards in the porch, which you can complete and send to your MP. Please remember to affix a stamp. A Ten Minute Rule Bill will be introduced on Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2018.

#### **HOLY WATER**

For those of you who wish to replenish your Holy Water supply in your homes, we now have a special container which has a tap, so that you may fill your own container. This silver coloured churn is located in the Retro Chapel, on a table in the left hand corner beside the Sanctuary. The easiest way to get to it is through the archway beside Our Lady's Altar. Please be considerate of others when you are using this facility.

#### **GIFT AID MATTERS**

If you would like to enquire about joining the Gift Aid Scheme, please contact the Gift Aid Organiser via the Parish Office. If you are a taxpayer, and meet the requirements of the scheme, the Church can reclaim the tax you have paid, at no cost to yourself! For those already in the Gift Aid scheme, please destroy old envelopes, and only use those coloured light green for main collections and yellow for second collections as clearly marked. If you miss a weekly offering, just discard the envelope and put your offering in the next one. You do not need to use every one. Only current Gift Aid members are permitted to use envelopes. Please avoid using multiple envelopes each week. If you have exited the Gift Aid scheme, please stop using your envelopes, even if you have crossed out the number and date.
