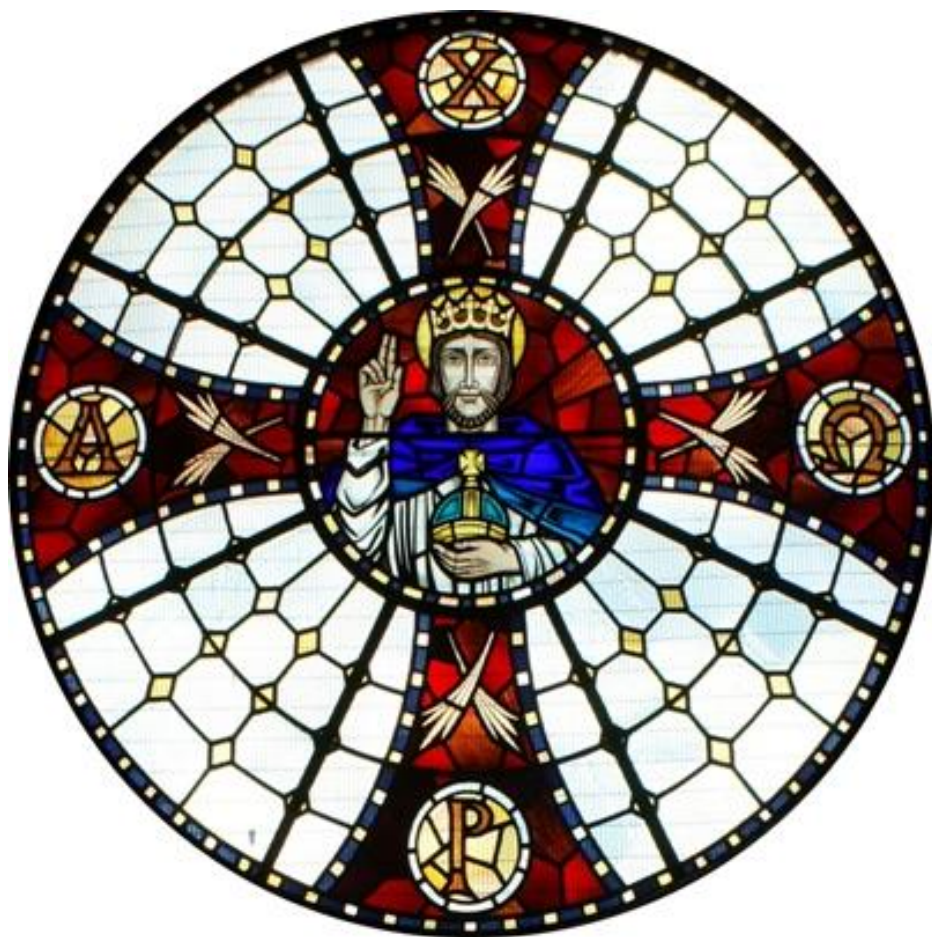

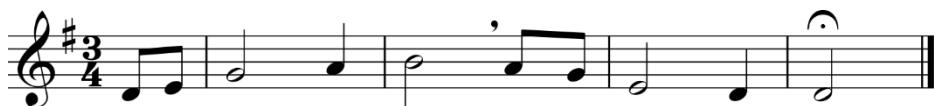

Easter Alleluia: *Repeat Father Deo's intonation (each time)*




