As we are now privileged, at St. Bartholomew's, to be invited to adore Our Lord every day, it is hoped that more of our Parish Community will answer Christ's call. Even a brief visit, maybe a few minutes out of a busy day, can bring great Graces and Blessings. With very young children this can gradually be built up into longer visits as they come to appreciate and love God's presence and never-ending Love for them and their Parents.

There is a touching story of a man who, daily, would pop into church and say, "Jesus, this is Jim. I have to be going now. Will you come with me?" then leave. One day he had a fatal accident. As he lay there, life ebbing away, he heard: "Jim, this is Jesus. I have to be going now. Will you come with me?". The lesson here is that if we are, to the best of our understanding and ability, faithful to Jesus, He will amply repay our love when we die.

On Good Friday alone, the Tabernacle lies empty. Even then we ought to be reverent in church; how much more, then, we ought at other times, to show those who see us, believers or not, that we are, truly, in the Presence of God. Bishop Emeritus Fabian Bruskewitz, has this to say: "...we should (even) try to be respectful and silent in church after Mass, in consideration of those who may be trying to make their thanksgiving Prayers".

We are very fortunate here, that many fellow Parishioners pray the Morning Prayer of the Church before weekday Mass and, afterwards, pray a decade of the Rosary. Why not join them in Prayer, both for ourselves, our Families and for our suffering Brothers and Sisters who may, even today, be killed for publicly showing the Faith we take for granted!
