#### A Thought

How often have even friends fallen out because, in being truthful, one has told the other something he or she didn't like hearing; the fact that what was said, was said out of loving concern, is completely overlooked. Today we see such a situation in the making as Jesus, having spent three years teaching about the Love of God, healing and bringing Truth, life and joy, has, in the eyes of the powers that be - whom He has already exposed in their hypocrisy - had the temerity to object to the abuse of the Temple for financial gain rather than its being reverently used as a place of Prayer. On Good Friday we shall hear how, encouraged by those who rejected Christ's Truth, many who had, today, cheered Jesus as King, would then go on to call for His Death on the Cross. Our Lord, in ejecting those who profaned the Temple, taught us a vital lesson; we may, sometimes, have to risk unpopularity in order to stand up for what is right; it may see us fall in the 'ratings' but, in sticking to the truth, we know that God's Will prevails; it is our fidelity to God which will bring us safely into Heaven rather than being thought well of in the here and now!
