## A Thought

There is a very beautiful hymn, very appropriate to this Solemnity which, fortunately, has not been excluded from modern Catholic hymn-books. In it we pray, “*Come Holy Ghost, Creator, Come.....take possession of our Souls and make them all thine own*”. Today we celebrate what is sometimes referred to as *the Birthday of the Church*, the day when, Confirmed by the Holy Spirit, the timid, fearful and, perhaps, uncertain Apostles, the first Bishops of the Catholic Church boldly emerged from their hiding place. Strengthened by the Gifts of the Spirit, given to each of us at our Confirmation, they gave, literally, their all. They received:

**Wisdom**, which helps us choose God's way of living, understanding the (often challenging) teachings of the Church, having compassion for and tolerance of the weak, whilst also being ever ready to ‘grasp the nettle’, to be unpopular (aka politically incorrect) and point out error, even if we are not thanked for it!  
**Right Judgement** helps us make choices to live as a faithful follower of Jesus, to see the dangers of certain ‘alternative’ ways of living.

**Courage** helps us stand up for our faith in Christ, avoiding anything which the world promotes, but which will separate us from God; this may even separate us from friends who can't or won't accept our beliefs, nor accept why we live as we do.

**Knowledge**, also, helps us choose the path that will lead to God. It encourages us to avoid whatever keeps us from him.

**Reverence** helps us confidently obey God, and inspires us to joyfully want to serve Him and others.

**Wonder** and **Awe** bring us to see how utterly great God is, and to love Him so much that we do not want to offend him by anything we say or do. This Gift is also known as ‘**Fear of The Lord**’, which, if explained *correctly*, emphasises love and devotion which move us to obey God; far from fearing so Loving a Father, we fear the sins which can separate us from Him.

How child-like are we in our following of God? Let us pray in earnest for a renewal of these Gifts in our souls and in the souls of our young people who are growing up in an increasingly godless world.

**GIFT AID ENVELOPES:**

**Boxes of new envelopes are available from today.**

Please collect these, along with your end of year statement, from the usual room on the right hand side of the passage way at the very front of the church. A member of the Gift Aid team will be on hand to deal with any questions you may have. This is also a good time to consider, if you do not already do so, making your contributions to the Parish, using the Gift Aid Scheme, **provided that you are a tax payer**. The great advantage is that, if you give regularly, using Gift Aid, **the Church can claim back 25p for every £1 you put into the collection**. And all *you* have to do is sign a form! If you wish, you may also pay by standing order for regular donations, with envelopes supplied for second collections. Gift Aid is a vital source of income for the parish. During the financial year ended April 2014, we reclaimed **£17,687.36** from HMRC!!!
