Today marks the 100th anniversary of the Armistice (which ended the Great War, as the First World War was known) which was signed in a railway carriage, at Compiègne, situated in the Oise department of Northern France, at the 11th hour on the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918. The 11.30am Mass today will be attended by our uniformed groups, who will pay tribute to our war dead, whilst the Plainchant Choir will be providing fitting solemn music. John Byrne will be representing our parish, laying a wreath at Streatham War Memorial during the Civic Service of Remembrance which commences at 10.30am this morning.
